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

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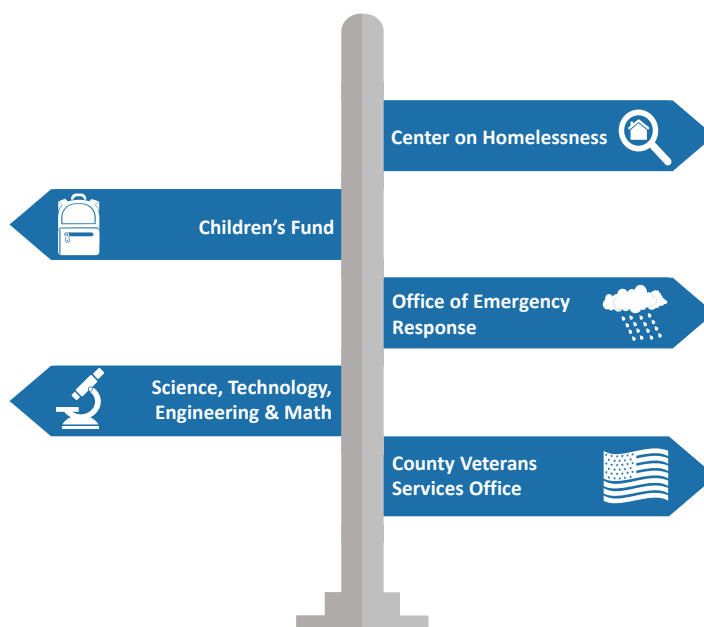

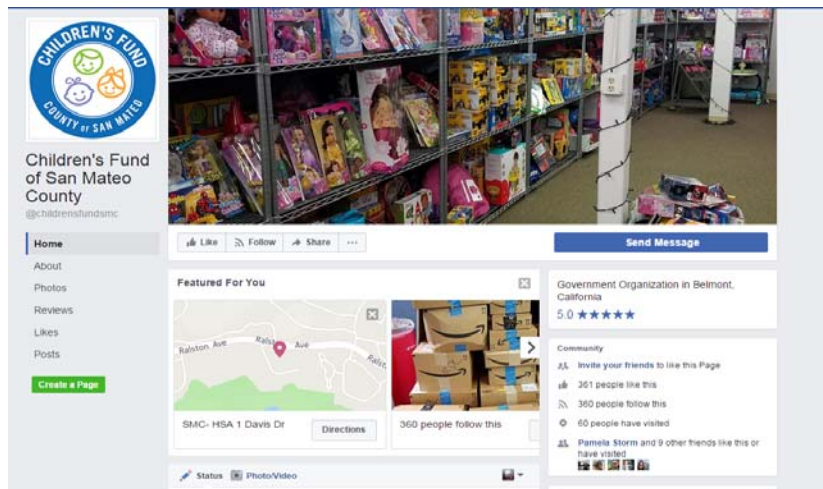
Volunteer! The Children's Fund relies heavily on the help and support of volunteers throughout the community. Some of the larger programs host 15 or more volunteers a week!

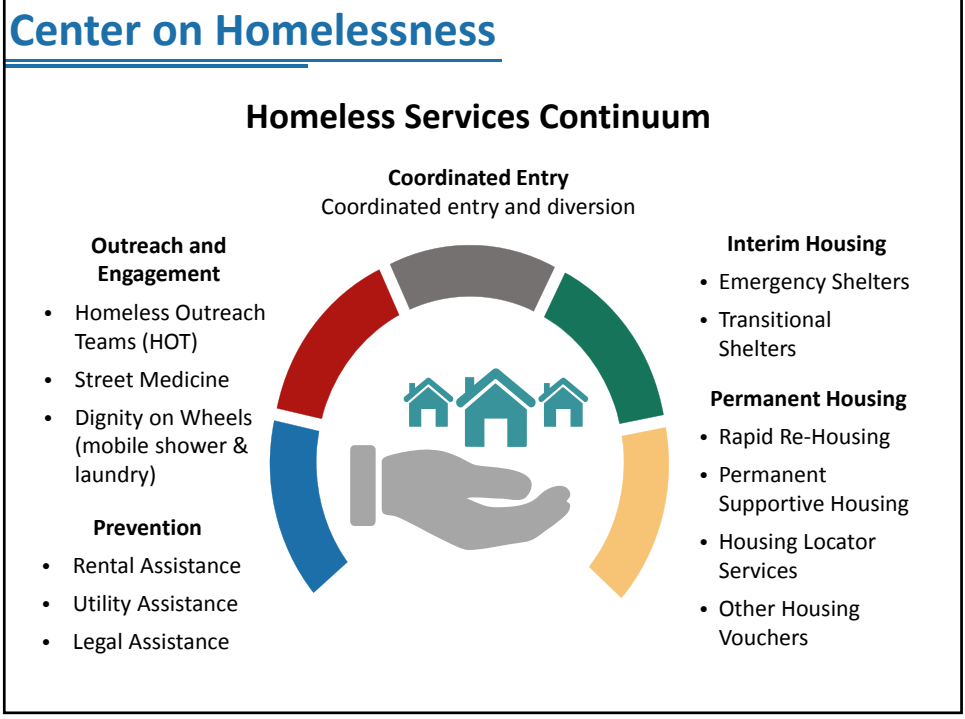

Office of Emergency Response

During an emergency or disaster, HSA

- Staff are required to report to duty
- May initiate a temporary (stand-up) Evacuation Center or Shelter Staff
- Assist with client care
- Work in partnership with the American Red Cross
