

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on May 25, 2021 at 9:00 a.m. local time (PDT) or as soon thereafter as the matter can be heard, via toll free telephonic means accessible to the general public as described below, a public hearing as required by Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (the “Code”), and Internal Revenue Code Procedure 2020-21 (“Rev Proc 20-21”) will be held with respect to a proposed plan of financing by the San Mateo County Joint Powers Financing Authority (the “Authority”) of its revenue bonds in two or more series issued from time to time, including bonds issued to refund such revenue bonds in one or more series from time to time, in an amount not to exceed \$40,000,000 with respect to its Refunding Lease Revenue Bonds, 2021 Series A and not to exceed \$265,000,000 with respect to its Lease Revenue Bonds (Refunding and Capital Projects), 2021 Series A-1 and Series A-2 (collectively, the “Bonds”).

Not to exceed \$180,000,000 of the Bonds will be issued (i) to finance the acquisition, construction and improvements of certain mental health facilities owned by the County, known as the Cordilleras Mental Health Center, and located at 200 Edmonds Rd, Redwood City, CA, (ii) to pay costs of issuance of the Bonds, and (iii) to pay capitalized interest on the Bonds.

At the time set for the public hearing, pursuant to Rev Proc 20-21, interested persons will be given a reasonable opportunity to express their views, both orally (via telephonic participation) and in writing on the issuance of such Bonds or on the nature and location of the facilities proposed to be financed and/or refinanced. Members of the public may listen to and contribute to any discussion during the hearing by: (1) dialing toll-free 1-877-211-3621; and (2) entering conference passcode 568337# at the prompt. Persons wishing to participate should submit a written request to speak to rmanchia@smcgov.org at least 24 hours before the hearing, however the hearing officer will also provide a time for additional comments at the end of the hearing. Oral remarks may not exceed five minutes in duration.
